

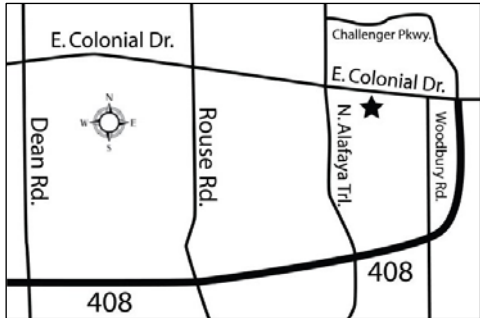

<p>A product may be hazardous waste if the label includes any of the following words: pesticide, caustic, acid, poison, flammable, warning or danger.</p>

If containers are leaking, pack them in a larger container with an absorbent material, such as cat litter, to soak up leaks. **DO NOT MIX** materials into a single container. Label the material. If you do not know what the material is, label it **UNKNOWN**. Only hazardous waste and electronic waste from Orange County homes will be accepted.

Please DO NOT BRING: Biologically Active Materials, Radioactive Materials, Explosives, Ammunition or Tires.
