While the Green Community Festival takes place at Liberty Park, AERC will be hosting its Electronics Recycling Collection Event at Peapack-Gladstone Bank's parking lot from 12PM to 4PM. The Peapack-Gladstone Bank is located diagonally across the street from Liberty Park at 190 Main Street in Peapack-Gladstone. The Electronics Recycling Collection Event will take place in a portion of the bank's parking lot, the remainder of the parking lot will be available for parking to those attending the Green Community Festival.

The general public is invited to drop off printers, scanners, CPUs, computer monitors, laptops, internal computer components, telephones, telecommunication equipment, cameras, radios, modems, pagers, VCRs, DVD players, hand held games, televisions, fluorescent bulbs and batteries. AERC will collect \$2 per computer monitor, \$15 per television, \$1 for all other electronic devices, \$0.30 per fluorescent bulb and \$0.40 per pound on batteries. These fees are to offset transportation, staffing and processing costs. All acceptable materials will be recycled at AERC's NAID Certified Electronics Processing Com-Cycle facility in Allentown, Pennsylvania.

“By supporting environmental organizations and events with an environmental cause, AERC hopes to raise awareness about the direct impact that individuals and organizations have on the environment with various waste handling methods. As a local community member, I am very proud of offering my neighbors the opportunity to dispose of their electronics and hope that AERC's efforts will make the community more cognizant of the quantity of waste they produce as well as the manner in which they dispose of it. It is each individual's personal responsibility to make the right decisions when it comes to managing the waste that they produce,” says Lindsay Landmesser.

AERC maintains a Zero-Waste-to-Landfill Policy for all of its electronics/ electrical recycling services. AERC maintains a strict policy on all data storage devices. All data on data storage devices will either be

wiped to the Department of Defense Standards or physically destroyed. No information containing devices will leave any AERC facility. In addition to offering similar electronics recycling events throughout the country, all AERC facility locations host Drop-Off Fridays every Friday between the hours of 9AM and 3PM.
