Only small quantities of electronics and certain Universal Waste materials will be accepted at this event.

AERC will be collecting a nominal fee for any acceptable materials that are dropped off for recycling. These fees are to offset transportation, staffing and processing costs. The general public is invited to drop off printers, scanners, CPUs, computer monitors, laptops, internal computer components, telephones, telecommunication equipment, cameras, radios, modems, pagers, VCRs, DVD players, hand held games, televisions, fluorescent bulbs and batteries. AERC will collect \$20 per television, \$10 per computer monitor, \$2 for all other electronic devices, \$0.30 per fluorescent bulb and \$0.75 per pound on batteries.
